



2011 Community Grants



In December of 2011, the Board of Autism Speaks Canada approved 26 Grants for 2011 totalling over \$569,000. Over the first 2 years of the program more than \$1 million has been directed to support grants in Canada

Twenty-six organizations in eight provinces from Newfoundland and Labrador across the country to British Columbia will receive funding in this round. Education, Recreation/Community Activities, Young Adult/Adult Services and Equipment/Supportive Technology are the four key areas of need addressed in Canadian grant program.
